Orthodontics is a specialised branch of dentistry which helps correct the position of your teeth and jaws, with aim of establishing a beautifully balanced smile, normal bite and improved self-esteem & confidence.

Who should have Orthodontics?

Treatment can be provided at ANY age from childhood to adulthood, with modern braces which are tooth-coloured (such as the Clarity™ Braces © 2006 3M Unitek, all rights reserved, seen in these photographs) and designed to achieve optimal results in the shortest time permissible.

Orthodontics in **CHILDREN** is designed to treat a wide range of problems from: Crooked teeth; Protruding front teeth, Reverse bites, Missing teeth and unattractive Gaps between the teeth.

Orthodontics in **ADULTS** can be used to treat the **same** range of problems seen in children, with increasing numbers of adults now seeking treatment as the benefits of braces in achieving beautiful natural smiles is becoming more evident. With specialist training the orthodontist can work with your dentist, periodontist, implantologist for a smile that looks as great as it feels.


